



## 15th National Games One-year Countdown Sharing Session cum Futsal Exchange Demonstration

### Aims / Objectives

This is to invite primary and secondary schools to nominate students to participate in the captioned activity.

### Details

2. The National Games (NG), held once every four years, are the nation's highest-level and the largest national multisport event. The 15th National Games would be co-hosted in Guangdong, Hong Kong and Macao in 2025. This is the first time for Hong Kong to be a co-host of the National Games. The three sides will also co-host the 12th National Games for Persons with Disabilities and the 9th National Special Olympic Games, to be held after the 15th National Games.

3. In response to this major sports event, the EDB will organise the “15th National Games One-year Countdown Sharing Session cum Futsal Exchange Demonstration” at C.C.C. Heep Woh Primary School (Cheung Sha Wan) on 22 November 2024 (Friday). Mr CHUNG Chi-kwong, Honorary Fellow of The Education University of Hong Kong and renowned sport commentator, is invited to be the guest speaker to share valuable experience in interviewing and commenting on major sports events, as well as guiding students to appreciate and grasp the highlights of the NG.

4. Under the “Active Students, Active People” Campaign (ASAP Campaign)<sup>2</sup>, the EDB has also invited the active or former members of the Hong Kong, China futsal team who currently serve as physical education teachers to share their experiences and challenges in training and competition, and conduct an exchange demonstration with the students on-site to enhance their understanding and interest in futsal, promoting sports ambience in schools. 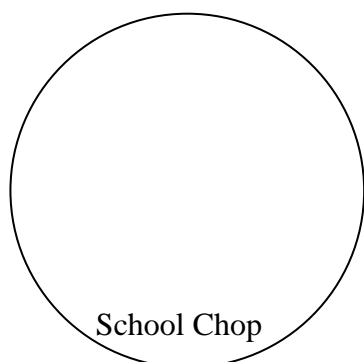
