#### **Market Commentaries**

- During the quarter, global equity markets increased due to the roll-out of COVID-19 vaccines and expectation of launching more fiscal stimulus measures in US.
- On increased market concerns over inflation, the US 10-year Government bond yield increased from around 0.8% by end of November 2020 to around 1.4% by end of February 2021.
- For the quarter ended 28 February 2021, the Hang Seng index increased by about 10% from 26,341 as at end of November 2020 to 28,980 by end of February 2021, while the Dow Jones Industrial Average Index increased by about 4.4% from 29,638 to 30,932 during the same period.
