Importance of Free Play

Socio-emotion

Play promotes impulse control and emotion regulation.



Language

Play improves communication and vocabulary.

Creativity Play helps generate creative ideas.

Intelligence

Play stimulates brain development.

Practical skills to promote free play at home



Use the objects surrounding children to encourage play play with anything, anywhere



Get toys with no rules boost children's imagination and creativity



Let children expand their critical thinking skills, to adapt and be flexible during plays



For messy play control the portion and time, get ready with tools that help clearing up
